Dear Mr. Nagle:

Congratulations on your achievement of becoming a participant in the DARPA Grand Challenge. As you know, after our 22 February 2003 Competitors Conference, DARPA made four major modifications to the proposed rules.

1. The maximum corrected time to receive the Grand Challenge Prize is ten hours.
2. The participating teams are not required to provide a Control (Safety) Vehicle.
3. The participating teams are not required to develop an Emergency-Stop system. DARPA will provide an E-stop for all teams.
4. There is no specific requirement for general liability insurance for individual teams.

Attached is a Grand Challenge Bailment Agreement. The Agreement addresses issues on the Challenge vehicle control, allocation of ownership and rights in certain data, government furnished equipment, and insurance and liability. Execution of this agreement is a requirement for participation in the Grand Challenge.
